What's in a Soil Group Worksheet (Agricultural Tax Assessment)?

How Conservation Districts Help:

Soil and Water Conservation Districts are charters of the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets. It is our job to work with everyone from individual farmers to federal organizations to implement projects concerning natural resource concerns and agronomic practices. Although the tools used to construct a SGW are all public information, due to the sensitive nature of the report New York State law mandates that Districts provide this service to its local landowners.

How do we Assemble Soil Group Worksheets?

To begin, first we identify and outline the entire tax parcel. If it's a new parcel or has been recently merged or split, then we obtain the updated parcel map and information from the county's Real Property office.

Once the parcel's boundaries are known, we ouline the different land uses into two or three categories: Agricultural Land, Farm Woodland and Non Agricultural Land. If you own and farm the parcel, you'll receive partial credit for the Farm Woodland in the exemption. If you rent the farmland out to someone, the Woodland is categorized as Non Ag Land, and you will not receive an agricultural adjustment for these areas. "For exact definitions of land use types, please see the back of ADP-1 form".

After the land use types are defined, we find out which types of soils are in the Agricultural Land and calculate the acreages for each soil type and group them together on the Soil Group Worksheet form (ADP-1).

This is what the assessor uses to adjust your taxes based upon the property's soil types.


What We Need From You:

In addition to your basic contact information (Name, mailing address, and phone number, email), a few pieces of information about your parcel is needed. This information can be found on your Tax Bill, the letter from your assessor or online.

- Tax Parcel Acreage

Other Property Questions

- Estimated acreage of woods, including hedgerows, drainage areas and riparian buffers.
- Number and types of buildings.
- Do you farm the land yourself or rent it out?
- Recent changes to the property; such as clearing of woods, merges/splits with other parcels, or change of ownership.

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Agriculture Assessment Program

The agricultural assessment program allows eligible farmland owners to receive real property assessments based on the value of their land for agricultural production rather than on its development value. Any assessed value which exceeds the equalized agricultural assessment on the land may qualify for a reduced tax assessment.
